Design Your Own Endowed Scholarship

Through the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Foundation, you can design a scholarship in the way that means the most to you. Your scholarship is an investment in the lives of deserving young men and women of ability and determination, and the future of the beef and ranching industry.

Personalize Your Scholarship

- By **major**, such as Animal Science, Range Management, Veterinary Science
- By **academic achievement**, such as GPA or other academic requirement
- By **involvement**, such as community service or through special organizations
- By **geography**, such as students from certain regions or counties of Texas or Oklahoma
- By **financial need**, such as low or middle income students
- By **other qualifications**, such as first-generation college students

Fund Your Scholarship

- An individual or group can establish a named endowed scholarship with a minimum gift of \$50,000 that can be paid over a period of up to four years.
- Funding can occur through gifts of cash, stocks, mutual funds, and other marketable property.
- Scholarships can also be endowed through a bequest or other charitable giving instruments (gift annuities, trust, etc.).



Name Your Scholarship

- The endowed scholarship's name is selected by the benefactor, in consultation with the Foundation's staff.
- Benefactor(s) of the named scholarship fund may establish the scholarship in their own name, or in memory or honor of a friend or family member.
- Scholarships may also be named in honor of a ranch or other entity.

Leave Your Legacy

- Named endowed scholarships establish an individual scholarship that will benefit future generations in perpetuity. The endowed fund's principal stays intact permanently with a percentage of the earnings allocated for scholarship support.
- Named scholarships and benefactors will have their name displayed within the Cattle Raisers Museum in Fort Worth, Texas.
- New endowed scholarship donors will be formally recognized in Foundation publications and scholarship advertisement.
- An endowed scholarship can establish a direct connection between the donor and the student. You will be provided an opportunity to correspond with the student who receives your scholarship award.
