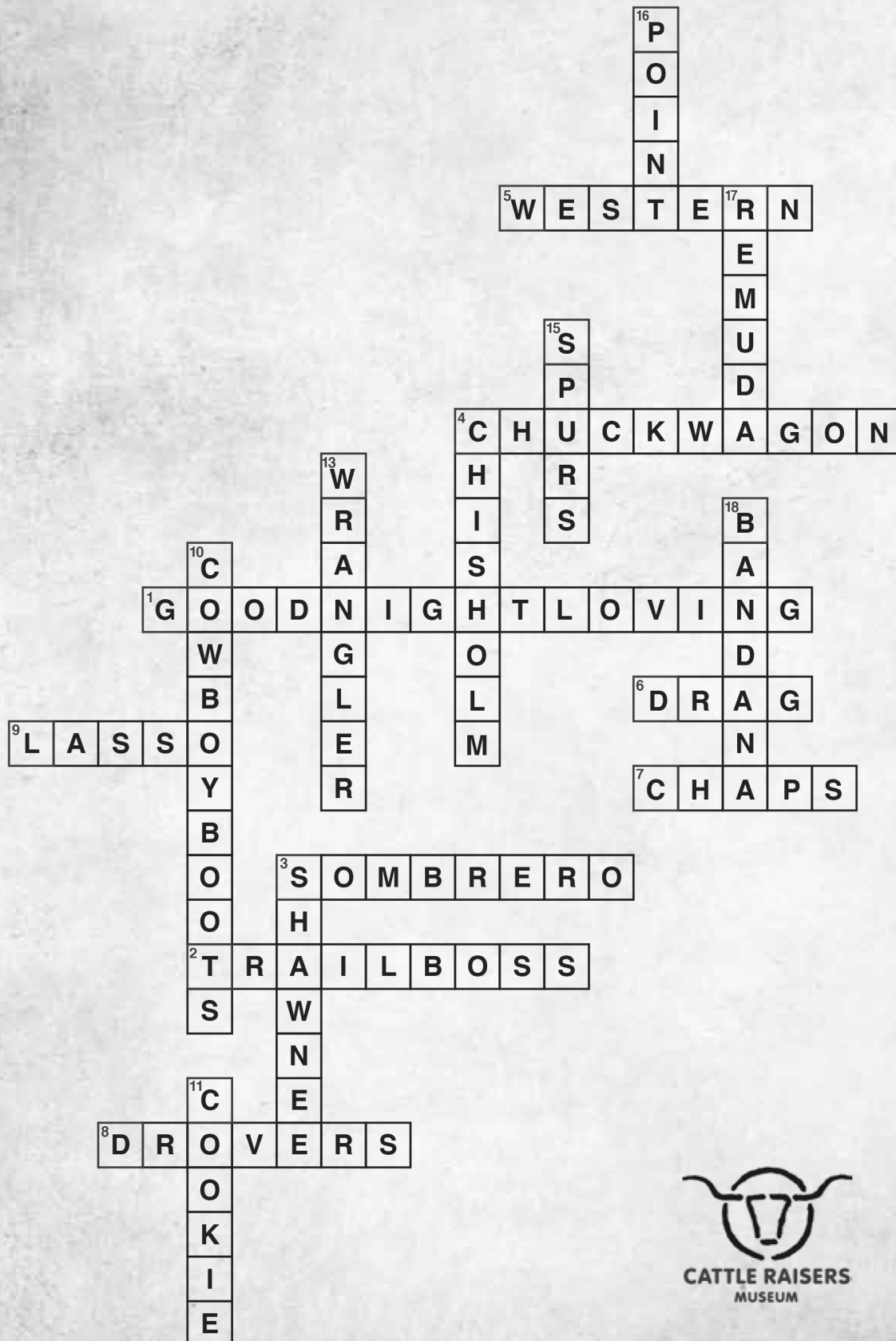


# CATTLE RAISERS CROSSWORD 2
