



DR. BRYAN L. FLOW VETERINARY SCHOLARSHIP

The Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Foundation is offering the Dr. Bryan L. Flow Veterinary Scholarship to a graduating high school or undergraduate student pursuing a degree plan in Animal Science or Veterinary Science with the intent to work as a mixed or large animal veterinarian in a rural community. This scholarship is a one-year award. Recipients are eligible to re-apply for an additional year, however recipient is not guaranteed an additional year.

QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible for the 2022-2023 scholarship, an applicant must:

- **Be accepted or enrolled at an accredited university in Texas or Oklahoma and pursuing a degree plan in Animal Science or Veterinary Science with the intent to work as a mixed or large animal veterinarian in a rural community**
- Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Texas
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Transcripts from all colleges attended must be submitted. If currently a high school senior, please include high school transcript
- Demonstrate financial need
- Be a member or sponsored by a member of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association
- Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from someone other than relatives
- Have a background that includes having showed cattle or other livestock during high school at stock shows around the state of Texas

Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, gender, religion or ethnicity.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The scholarship will be paid by check payable to the university that the student will be attending during the upcoming 2022 fall semester. **Payment to the University is dependent on the recipient registering for the required major designated for this scholarship.** The check will be issued by the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Foundation and mailed to the university. The scholarship will be paid in two equal payments. One payment will be made for the fall semester and the second payment for the spring semester.

In the event the scholarship recipient fails to meet the enrollment requirements by Sept. 30th, the award will be forfeited. Should the recipient fail to meet the requirements to receive the second half of the scholarship funds, the award will be forfeited.

Failure to meet any of the award requirements will be considered a breach of the scholarship agreement and is grounds for revoking a scholarship.



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APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applications can be submitted either by uploading the application and the required documents on-line or by mailing the application and the required documents to our office.

Recommendation forms MUST be mailed into our office. If being mailed in with the application, recommendation forms must be placed in separate, sealed and signed envelopes and attached to the application packet.

Any application not filled out completely and/or missing any of the required documents will be deemed incomplete and will not be considered.

All information provided on the application will be handled in a confidential manner by the Foundation.

Please complete the application in its entirety and return with the following required documents:

- A photo of applicant, headshot is preferred (size 4x6 or 3x5). If uploading your photo, it needs to be in a jpg format. If mailing in photo, please forward an actual photo (no photocopies) and write name on the back.
- Transcripts (preferably official transcripts, however if official transcripts are not available by the application deadline, we will accept unofficial transcripts).
- Personal Essay telling us about yourself, your educational objectives, what life's work you are preparing yourself for by attending college and why you believe you should be a recipient of this scholarship. Also include in your essay: ***"How you intend to participate in and contribute to the cattle industry and culture."***
- Two recommendation forms completed by someone other than a relative utilizing the form provided. Recommendation forms **MUST** be mailed into our office regardless if submitting application on-line or mailing application. **If included with application, recommendation forms must be placed in a separate sealed, signed envelope by the person filling out the form and attached to the application packet.**

All application materials must be received in our office no later than February 4, 2022. Postmarks will not be accepted. Applications received after February 4 will not be accepted. Applications can be mailed to the following:
